



How to Install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

▲ Warning!

When installing, read your Vehicle Service Manual.

⚠ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

Loosen the pull rods of the suspension linkage at the swing arm, remove the upper and lower shock absorber attachement bolts.

Remove the original shock absorber.

• Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the same way as the original unit. Do not tighten yet.

• Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

Tighten the attachment bolts to correct torque according to Kawasaki specification.

Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
