
If working on a raised vehicle, ensure it is securely supported so that it will not tip over.

#### 1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground. Make sure the motorcycle is in a stable position.

# 2


On LH&RH side : Loosening the screw (1) to remove the cover and remove the plastic cover by unlocking plastic clip lock (2).

On LH&RH side : Remove the plastic cover (1) by loosening 3 screws, for access to the shock absorber.





### 4

Uninstall the original shock absorber by loosening the upper and lower mounting bolts (1) (2).

### 5

Install the Öhlins shock absorber, by using the original bolts.

Tighten at a torque value as specified in the service manual and reverse all procedures.


# Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before tightening the screws.

# "Caution!

Ensure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.


